 - Product uniqueness and quality
 - Professional presentation
 - Operational readiness
 - Full regulatory compliance
 - Ability to contribute positively to festival atmosphere
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VENDOR CATEGORIES & FEES

Vendor placement, approval, and category caps will be intentionally curated to maintain balance, variety, and overall event experience.

FOOD & BEVERAGE Vendors **Fee: \$375 per booth**

MANDATORY: Approval from Simcoe Muskoka District Health Unit Compliance with Town of BWG food safety standards Temporary Food Vendor Permit (where required) Minimum \$2,000,000 Commercial General Liability Insurance naming: The Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury

FOOD TRUCK **Fee: \$475 per booth**

Includes:

- Dedicated truck placement
- High-visibility positioning
- Inclusion in vendor promotions

MANDATORY: SMDHU approval Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury Refreshment Vehicle Licence \$2,000,000 Commercial General Liability Insurance Fire suppression compliance (if cooking with propane/open flame)



KEY SELLING POINTS



WHAT VENDORS RECEIVE

- 10-hour operating window (1 PM – 11 PM)
- Peak afternoon family traffic
- Strong evening crowd driven by live entertainment
- Central downtown Public Square location
- Event-wide marketing and promotion
- Professional event management & on-site security
- Licensed beer garden increasing dwell time and evening purchasing
- Structured layout to maximize traffic flow

TOWN LICENSING & COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

All vendors must comply with applicable Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury regulations, which may include:

- Business licensing (if operating within town limits)
- Refreshment vehicle licensing (food trucks)
- Electrical safety compliance (ESA approval if using generators or temporary power)
- Fire safety compliance for cooking vendors
- Waste management standards



PAYMENT TERMS

- 50% Deposit due upon signing
- Balance due by May 1, 2026
- Vendor space confirmed only upon receipt of deposit
